AFI 51-601, 26 November 2003, is supplemented as follows: It applies to all Air Mobility Command (AMC) activities and members. This supplement applies to AMC gained Air National Guard (ANG) units and members when published in ANGIND2. It also applies to AMC gained Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC) units and members during post-mobilization periods, when published in AFRCIND2.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

1.3.9. AMC/CC delegates the authority to accept or reject gifts to the Air Force of tangible or intangible personal property valued at \$50,000 or less to the numbered Air Force commander, all expeditionary mobility task force commanders, and all installation commanders within Air Mobility Command.

1.4. **Gifts of Real Property That May Be Accepted or Rejected Below Secretarial Level.** The validity of the re-delegation of authority contained in AFI 51-601, paragraph 1.4., to accept or reject specific gifts is questionable due to a conflict with a SAF/IEI memo to AFRPA/DR (*SAF/IEI Re-delegations of Authorities Pursuant to Secretary of the Air Force Order SAFO*) 700.4, *Real Property Acquisition*, dated 13 May 03). In this memo, SAF/IEI re-delegated to AFRPA/DR his authority to accept gifts, devise and bequests of real property under paragraph 2b of SAFO 700.4, subject to the condition that the re-delegation does not authorize the acceptance of any such gift, devise or bequest of real property that is valued at more than \$10,000.00 or that requires expenditures for acceptance and annual maintenance in excess of \$1,000.00. The SAF/IEI letter specifically indicates that this authority may not be further re-delegated. Until this apparent conflict is resolved through a properly promulgated order or instruction, AMC units will process these types of gifts IAW the above referenced SAF/IEI memo.

2.2. **Transmittal of an Offer.** Send one copy of any offers to HQ AMC/JAC, 102 E. Martin St., Room N-119, Scott AFB IL 62225-5012.

5.3.1. AMC/CC delegates the authority to accept or reject gifts offered to the Air Force for distribution to Air Force members and employees, when the total value is \$50,000 or less, to the numbered Air Force commander, all expeditionary mobility task force commanders, and all installation commanders within Air Mobility Command.

5.3.2. AMC/CC delegates to the numbered Air Force commander, all expeditionary mobility task force commanders, and all installation commanders within Air Mobility Command the authority to receive, and to determine the method of distribution of, gifts that have been accepted for distribution to personnel solely within their respective commands.

5.3.3. AMC/CC delegates to all overseas installation commanders within Air Mobility Command the authority to receive, and to determine the method of distribution of, gifts from donors located within their geographic area, which are intended for distribution to personnel solely within their respective commands.
