This mission directive implements policy guidance in AFD 10-1, *Mission Directives*, AFI 10-101, *Format and Content of Mission Directives* and AFI 38-101, *Air Force Organization*. The mission directive defines the mission, command relationship, responsibilities, and organization of the Security Forces Squadron. It also applies to the Air National Guard and Air Force Reserve units, effective upon the date of unit activation. **AMCMD 706 will be superseded in phases. Each organization identified in AMCMD 706 will be replaced by a AMCMD 7XX series publication. Once all Mission Directives have been issued AMCMD 706 will be rescinded in its entirety.**

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

- 1. Mission.** The Security Forces Squadron protects the Air Force combat capability of assigned forces both at the home base and at the deployed location.
- 2. Command.** The Security Forces Squadron is assigned to the Mission Support Group.
- 3. Responsibilities:**
 - 3.1. Maintains law and order on the installation by:
 - 3.1.1. Developing and maintaining a viable detection program.
 - 3.1.2. Organizing, equipping, training, and administering forces to participate in prompt and sustained operations.
 - 3.1.3. Providing ground weapon training and administering forces to participate in prompt and sustained operations.

- 3.1.4. Managing the installation information security, resource protection, crime prevention, and security programs.
- 3.2. Providing security for and protecting all installation resources from sabotage, espionage, subversion, and attack.
- 3.3. Providing the combat capability to nullify or reduce the effectiveness of enemy Level 1 and Level II ground attacks.
