Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 22, United States Air Force Supply Manual, 1 July 2003, is supplemented as follows. This supplement applies to all Air National Guard (ANG) units. The supplement gives the ANG units an option for how to reflect the organization code for mobility weapons stored by supply. The Operations Officer and the Chief of Supply (COS) are one and the same when referenced in this supplement.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

Administrative changes to the numbers to match the basic publication are the only changes made.

22.214. Overview. All AF Arms as defined in volume 1, part 1, chapter 1, will be maintained on supply accountable records and require the maintenance of a serial number record for each weapon. Weapons will be accounted for in the Standard Base Supply System (SBSS) on Equipment Authorization In-Use Details (EAID) and the Air Force Equipment Management System (AFEMS).

22.218. Mobility Bag Element. The ANG base supply Mobility Bag Element will provide secure storage for mobility weapons when owning organizations have no secure storage or to accommodate local requirements. The Arming groups are identified in AFI 31-207, *Arming and Use of Force by Air Force Personnel*.

22.219. Storage. ANG units will elect one of these options for mobility weapons stored by the Operations Officer. Mobility weapons can reflect the organization code for the base supply Mobility Bag Element or reflect the organization code of the owning organization.

22.220. Management And Control Of Weapons. The Operations Officer will control access to the weapons vault.

22.220.1. The NCOIC of the Mobility Bag Element will be the custodian when mobility weapons reflect the organization code for the base supply Mobility Bag Element. Otherwise, the owning organization for each organization code will have their custodians assigned.

22.220.1.2. (Added) The NCOIC of the Mobility Bag Element with the Equipment Management Element (EME) will maintain management oversight and ensure all custodians storing their weapons with supply follow proper weapons management procedures.
