Air Force Manual 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 2, United States Air Force Supply Manual, 1 April 2004 is supplemented as follows. This publication applies to all Air National Guard (ANG) units.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

The required signature for the M10 is stated and an additional requirement for Base-Level Supply Customer Training is added.

2.13.16.1. (Added) The Logistics Readiness Officer (LRO) i.e., the Assistant United States Property and Fiscal Officer (USP&FO) for property will sign the M10. If the position is vacant the acting LRO or the Logistics Readiness Squadron (LRS) Commander will sign the M10.

2.58.1.3. (Added) In addition to the normal topics, Block I, training will include information on accounting for assets purchased with the Government Purchase Card (GPC) and qualify for accountability in accordance with (IAW) AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 13, Chapter 8, Section 8L.

2.58.4.3. (Added) Block III, training will include information on accounting for assets purchased with the GPC and qualify for accountability IAW with AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 13, Chapter 8, Section 8L.

2.73.8. Surveillance Inspection Program. ANG units will schedule and accomplish an aggressive surveillance inspection program for items in base supply storage semi-annually.
