This instruction outlines the preparation and use of ARPC Form 86, **Discharged Reservists Instructions**.

This instruction includes a requirement to maintain, collect, use, or disseminate information subject to the Privacy Act of 1974. AUTHORITY: Title 10 U.S.C., Section 12683.

- 1. Reference.** AFI 36-3209, *Separation and Retirement Procedures for Air National Guard and Air Reserve Members*.
- 2. Purpose.** ARPC Form 86 is sent to discharged reservists to instruct them as to where to send their old identification card.
- 3. Preparation.** ARPC/DPPS sends ARPC Form 86 to the discharged reservist with a discharge order and the DD 256AF, **Certificate of Discharge**.
- 4. Procedures.** The Reservist returns their identification card with the ARPC Form 86. If the reservist does not have an Identification Card he/she returns the ARPC Form 86 marked lost, stolen, never issued, or returned to a military unit for destruction. The form is signed by the reservist who includes their SSN and current address for easy identification.

5. **Form Prescribed.** ARPC Form 86.
