USE AND PREPARATION OF ARPC FORM 27

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This instruction outlines the preparation and use of ARPC Form 27, **Application for Professional Military Development Courses (In Residence)**.

This instruction includes a requirement to maintain, collect, use, or disseminate information subject to the Privacy Act of 1974. AUTHORITY: Title 10 U.S.C. 8013.

1. Purpose: To process Air Force Reservist's requests for resident Professional Military Education and Reserve courses.

2. Preparation. Part I is completed by the Reservist, part II by the Orderly Room, part III by the Reservist's rater, and part IV is completed by the MAJCOM/Senior MA..

3. Procedures:

3.1. ARPC Form 27 is filled out by the member to apply for Professional Military Education and Reserve courses (in Residence). Forwarded for approval through MAJCOM.

3.2. If the completed form is not forwarded by suspense dates, Reservist may not be considered for course.

4. Form Prescribed. ARPC Form 27.
