**AFMAN 23-110 Volume II, Part Two, Chap 25 is supplemented as follows:**

***SUMMARY OF REVISIONS***

**This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.**

25.11.1.5. The appropriate organization manager is responsible for all normal bench stock responsibilities.

25.16.3.1. The commanders option has been exercised. The unit bench stock monitor will input routine bench stock replenishment using G081.

25.17.2. The procedures in paragraph **25.17.2.1**. will be used.

25.17.2.1. From 0700-1600, Monday through Friday (normal duty hours), except holidays, urgent bench stock requirements, will be submitted to the Customer Service element (LGRSC). After normal duty hours, requests will be submitted to the Aircraft Parts Store. Urgent bench stock request will be processed for the exact quantity required, not the total bench stock authorization.

25.17.2.2. The commander chooses to use the Pickup and Delivery element for deliveries.
