12.5.5. Due Out Release (DOR) on-base delivery priorities:

DOR Priority	DELIVERY TIME
Mission Capable with Urgency Justification Codes of 1xx/Jxx	No later than 4 hours
02 – 03	No later than 4 hours
04 – Greater	No later than 12 hours or end of next duty day

12.18.3. Send a copy of the A907 reject notice to the Logistic Readiness Squadron (LRS) Resource Advisor. The LRS Resource Advisor will notify the Stock Control Liaison when sufficient funds are available to process a forced DOR.

12.20. Do not process TEX Code D due-outs without prior approval from the LRS Resource Advisor. For further information refer to AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Chapter 1, Part 10, Para 1.20.2.
