AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 20 is supplemented as follows:

20.5.2.2. Base Service Store/Individual Equipment Element inventories are not required. These functions are currently under private contract.

20.7.2. Inventory and warehouse supervisors will jointly develop an inventory and validation schedule.

20.10.3. Consolidated Inventory Adjustment Document Register program, M10/NGV836, is accessible through the Air Mobility Command Regional Supply Squadron (AMCRSS) link,
<https://amcrss.scott.af.mil/rssmain-frames.html>. Distribution for this listing is not required.

20.10.4. **NOTE:** Quarterly, the Inventory Section will report all suspect thefts to Commander, OSI Detachment; Chief, Security Police; and Chairman, Resource Protection Loss Prevention Work Group AFI 31-209.

20.12.2. The 436th Munitions Flight will provide documentation for type account K adjustments.

20.23.5. Inventory Section maintains one copy of the D818, Daily Cumulative Reject Listing, in terminal identification sequence, as a suspense file for rejects.

20.26.3. Only process Urgency of Need "A" requirements when item records are frozen for inventory.

20.27.1.2. The Z03, Complete Freeze Code Listing, can also be used to monitor "C" freeze codes.

20.40.2.1. The Z03, Complete Freeze Code Listing, will be used as the automated freeze code suspense file.

20.41.4. (Added) Inventory Section will notify the warehouse supervisor via e-mail or telephone upon completion of inventory.

20.45.2. Under the Standard Asset Tracking System (SATS) concept distribution of copies is not applicable/required. SATS label is only forwarded to Document Control Section when a paper copy is generated.

20.67. The Automated Transaction History Program will be used in-place of the Inventory Analysis Program. Additionally, this program will facilitate the research processes needed to identify trends to the Logistics Readiness Squadron Commander.
