27.25.3.1. The D043 will be used in lieu of DOD Cataloging Handbooks H4/H8 to validate or assign the Commercial and Government Entity.

27.25.5. The D043 will be used in lieu of DOD Master Cross Reference List to screen the part number and CAGE when converting the part number to an NSN.

27.28.2. The Standard Procurement System will be used to maintain the non-NSN description file.
