### **SUMMARY OF REVISIONS**

**This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.**

14.1.1. Personnel will use Supply Asset Tracking System (SATS) in lieu of the Standard Base Supply System, interface processing. Refer to 92 LRSI 23-301 for SATS procedures.

14.3.2. The Storage Element supervisor will incorporate the review of the reserve locations in the inspection program. Unnecessary reserve locations will be deleted.

14.7.2.2. Request for special inventory will be forwarded to the Storage Element Supervisor for further action.

14.13.1.6. 1GP will be forwarded to the Storage Element supervisor for further action.

14.14. According to a Blank Purchase Agreement (BPA) the respective unit is responsible for their gas cylinder requirements.

14.17.3.1. Medical certification for Issue Exception (IEX) code 9 issues will be obtained from the Director of the Base Medical Services (DBMS).

14.23.4.1. (Added) For LRS, Inspection must be decentralized and all inspection duties will be assigned to the functional area of responsibility.

14.26.1.4. The option to process a credit turn-in will be approved on a case by case basis by the Resource Management Section.

**NOTE:** Readiness Spares Packages (RSP) personnel will manage functional check assets in their area. Storage Element will conduct a monthly review.

14.40.7. MAJCOM has taken the option that all items requiring functional check will be identified by marking or stamping the words "Functional Check Required" in bold dark letters on the DD Form 1574/1574-1, Serviceable Tag Materiel, attached to the property.

**NOTE:** The Hazardous Material Management Program identified in AFI 32-7086 has been established.

14.41.3.3. Customer Support Center (CSC) will notify HQ AMC/RSS to load Shipment Exception (SEX) and Excess Exception (EEX) codes to radioactive items. This will prevent shipments or transfers (A5Js) being processed before proper authority is obtained from SA/ALC/MMIREP-2 and Bioenvironmental. CSC will work with the Storage Element to identify these items.

14.42.1. The Enterprise Environmental Safety Occupational Health Management Information System (EESOH-MIS) will be used instead of the HHAL to provide and obtain the necessary data.

14.51. The Vehicle Operations Section will perform all vehicle operation procedures outlined in section 14C.

14.55.2. The delivery driver will scan the customer's smart card for their PIN, which will serve as an electronic signature.

14.57.1.1. The delivery driver will annotate the SATS label/DD Form 1348-1A of the ISU/DOR.

14.73.2.8. Limited inspector training and certification will be documented in the individual's AF Form 797.

14B6.4. **NOTE 1:** Shop Code "VV" (004VV) will be reserved for the REMS Monitor.
