AFMAN 23-110, Volume II, Part Two, Chapter 17, is supplemented as follows:

This supplement establishes procedures for the 48th Logistics Readiness Squadron, RAF Lakenheath on how AWP details will be maintained. It applies to all units assigned to RAF Lakenheath.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This revision hands over the responsibilities of the Logistics Readiness Squadron to the USAFE Regional Supply Squadron Mission Capability Element. The supply representatives assigned to the 48th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron working in the Dedicated Aircraft Supply Support elements are responsible for overall management of MICAP requirements (paragraph 17.2.3.). It also covers validating/backordering request with URSS MICAP (paragraph 17.2.3.1.), coordinating with URSS MICAP to obtain current status (paragraph 17.2.3.2.), preparing/submitting Supply Difficulty Requests (paragraph 17.2.3.3.) and coordinating with URSS MICAP for processing cancellation requests (paragraph 17.2.3.4.). A bar (|) indicates revision from the previous edition.

17.2.3. The supply representatives (2S0X1) assigned to the 48th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron working in the Dedicated Aircraft Supply Support elements (Red, Blue and Gold) are responsible for overall management of MICAP requirements. This responsibility includes but is not limited to:

17.2.3.1. Validating/backordering request with URSS MICAP.

17.2.3.2. Coordinate with URSS MICAP to obtain current status.

17.2.3.3. Preparing/submitting Supply Difficulty Requests.

17.2.3.4. Coordinate with URSS MICAP for processing cancellation requests. **NOTE:** The Logistics Readiness Squadron will provide training and assistance as required.

17.27.2. These functions are performed by individual maintenance AWP monitors with oversight by the AWP monitor in the URSS Mission Capability Element.

17.27.2.1. Demands for parts will be placed on Standard Base Supply System or Integrated Logistics System Supply.

17.27.3. Awaiting Parts (AWP) end items will be stored in the maintenance shops. LRS Commander responsibilities are delegated to the AWP Monitor in the URSS Mission Capability Element.
