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AFMAN 23-110, Vol 2, Part 2, Chap 11, is supplemented as follows:

11.3.1. Spreadsheets or a logbook may be used in lieu of the AF Form 2005 (Issue/Turn-In Request). All processing requirements and timeframes applying to the AF Form 2005 equally apply to the spreadsheet or logbook. Each designated call-in point will establish local procedures.

11.5.1. Quick Reference Lists (QRL) are used and maintained by maintenance activities.

11.8.1. Delivery time requirements:

Priority 2 30 minutes

Priority 3 1 hour

Priority 4 -15 8 hours

Note: A special trip will not be made to meet priority 4 -15 timeframe, but will be delivered before the end of the next duty day.

11.31.2. The Repair Cycle Support Element will process Local Manufacture requests.
