**BENCH STOCK REPORT**

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**AFMAN 23-110, Vol 2, Part 2, Chap 25, is supplemented as follows:**

Added paragraph **25.10.3.1. (Added)** supplemented paragraph **25.16.3.1.1. (Added)**; and supplemented paragraph **25.17.2.2. A bar ( | ) indicates a change from the last edition.**

25.9. The supported organization will reorganize active bins when items are deleted from bench stock.

| 25.10.3.1. (Added) The BSSS will provide a list of detail numbers containing shelf life coded items to the Bench Stock monitors. Bench Stock monitors will mark specified bin labels with a green marker to identify shelf life coded items.

25.11.1.3.3. Hand tools will not be placed on bench stock.

| 25.16.3.1.1. (Added) The unit bench stock monitor will input routine bench stock replenishment requests over a remote terminal as soon as the 50 percent or below level is reached.

25.17.2. The Demand Processing Section or the Flightline Dedicated Support Center Section (FDSS) will process urgent bench stock requirements.

| 25.17.2.2. Urgent Bench Stock deliveries will follow normal issue procedures.

25.17.3. The Customer Service Section and FDSS will utilize the (R31/GV831) Due-Out Status Listing on a monthly basis to monitor due-out delays.

25.23.3.1. The semiannual review will not be conducted. The review will be conducted annually in conjunction with the annual SRD/MRA validation.

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
