AFI 31-205, 1 August 1995, is supplemented as follows:

33.1. Commanders (or a designated representative) who have personnel in confinement at the detention facility will visit their individuals at least once a week.

34.4. The installation chaplain will ensure one of the assigned chaplains visits the confinement facility at least once a week.

35.3. The inmate's unit commander will ensure inmates have all required clothing in accordance with Attachment 1 prior to entry into confinement. Inmates will not be received into confinement unless clothing requirements are met. Inmates being transferred to other facilities must meet clothing requirements as directed by HQ AFSPA/SPCI.

39.6. The unit to which a medium custody inmate is assigned will provide necessary escorts for inmates desiring to attend religious services and meet all appointments approved and determined necessary by the Corrections Noncommissioned Officer in Charge (NCOIC). The inmate's unit will telephone the NCOIC, Corrections, or the law enforcement desk to identify the escort by name and rank. This notification must be made by the squadron first sergeant, section commander, or commander. The escort will be in the grade of E-5 or above.

39.7. Prior to departing the detention area, the escort will sign a letter of "Receipt and Rules for Inmate Escorts", which states he/she fully understands his/her responsibility as an escort. Minimum custody prisoners and escorted medium-out custody prisoners are permitted to consume meals at the dining facility.
