SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

Renumbered and updated all paragraphs to correspond with basic manual.

AFMAN 23-110, Volume 1, Part 1, Chapter 12, is supplemented as follows:

12.5.1.3. Submit requests for initial spares support lists (ISSLs) to HQ PACAF/LGSW.

12.5.1.3.3. Prior to uploading the ISSL, the PACAF RSS funds manager will review the Monetary Impact Listing (R11) to determine the impact on the approved stock fund operating program. If the funds manager determines the approved operating program can absorb the ISSL dollar figure, requisitioning can begin. If not, delay requisitioning until it can be absorbed. The funds manager will ensure identification of the ISSL in the Automated General Support Operating Program (AGSOP).

12.5.2.7.2. Prior to the expiration of the ISSL, PACAF RSS Stock Control will review consumption data of affected stock numbers. If it appears the deletion of the ISSL will severely degrade system support, coordinate with the affected organization and HQ PACAF/LGSW for resolution.

12.45.2.1. The Chief of Supply (COS) is the approval authority for establishing temporary mission support kits (TMSK) as required. The COS may establish permanent mission support kits (PMSK), but authorization is only for assets with an established requisitioning objective (do not exceed). If developed, maintain and store the PMSK in the same palletized and containerized manner as other MRSP or IRSP. If the unit is authorized a MRSP or IRSP, completely document the rationale for needing a PMSK in addition to the MRSP or IRSP, and forward to HQ PACAF/LGSW for approval. Maintain documentation for the authorization's duration.

12.72.5. The COS is the final approval authority for establishing adjusted levels for budget code (BC) 9 ERRC XB3 and XF3 items.

Attachment 12F-2, Part II, NOTE 9. The COS is authorized to approve adjusted stock levels for BC NF2 XB3 and XF3 items with a net adjustment of \$5,000 or more.
