**SUMMARY OF REVISIONS**

Validated paragraphs to correspond to basic manual; added Issue Exception Code P for Air Force Repair Enhancement Program (AFREP) assets; and replaced references to Chief of Supply with Logistics Readiness Squadron Commander (LRS/CC). New or revised material is indicated by an A bar (|) indicates revision from the previous edition.

**AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 11, is supplemented as follows:**

| 11.3.2.2. The LRS/CC has the option to allow all requests for non-Equipment Authorization Inventory Data (EAID) items (activity code P) to be submitted to the Customer Service Center section.

11.3.3.4. Quick reference numbers may be used for call-ins.

| 11.4.1.2, Note. LRS/CC has the option to record supply action on the control register and the option whether or not to record and report delivery time for expedite issue documents.

| 11.4.1.2.1. LRS/CC has the option to destroy copy 2.

11A.1.3. Bases operating under Combat Oriented Supply Organization (COSO) will use procedures in PACAFI 23-203 for pick up and delivery processes.

For exception notice codes (ENC) 8 & 9, the PACAF RSS will process FNL inputs to change nomenclature to reflect requisitioning actions or information needed to satisfy customer requirements. An exception control card (ECC) image is not required for these codes.

Issue Exception Codes (IEX) P-Z are reserved for MAJCOM.
