AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 12, is supplemented as follows:

12.16.1. Line 2, replace Stock Control with "Base Customer Service (BCS)."

12.16.3.1. Lines 1 and 3, replace Stock Control with "BCS."

12.16.4.1. Change paragraph to read: " Documentation prepared. Once each month BCS requests that computer operations prepare due-out validation listings for all due-outs. When the due out listings are available, the BCS will forward a letter/email to organizations that have due-outs to notify them that they must perform a due-out validation. This letter should contain specific instructions detailing the actions they are required to perform."
