This supplement applies to Pacific Air Forces (PACAF) gained Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC) units and Air National Guard (ANG) units only upon mobilization unless specifically exempted.

**SUMMARY OF REVISIONS**

Renumbered and updated all paragraphs to correspond to basic manual. All references to Chief of Supply (COS) will now be referred to as Logistics Readiness Squadron commander (LRS/CC). Updated Major Command (MAJCOM) option for centrally storing all 1348-6 in Base Customer Service Center. Updated MAJCOM option for processing of recoverable assets (XD/XF) in Flightline Service Center. New or revised material is indicated by a bar (|).

**AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 14, is supplemented as follows:**

| 14.23.2. The LRS/CC has the option to assign inspection duties to the functional area of responsibility. The Material Management Section, Storage Element should be limited to those inspection duties requiring special expertise in determining serviceability or identification.

**NOTE:** MAJCOM Option. War Readiness will conduct the function check and the dated item review of all assets assigned to the MRSP.

14.24.2. The LRS/CC has the option of authorizing personnel in the responsible section (i.e., Receiving, Flight Service Center) to perform inspections on property turned in. Storage Element personnel can assist the responsible section in the inspection process if problems arise.

14.25.1. The LRS/CC has the option of authorizing personnel in the responsible section to perform inspections when property arrives. Storage Element personnel can assist the responsible section in the inspection process if problems arise.

14.26.1. The LRS/CC has the option of authorizing the Pickup and Delivery Section and/or Vehicle Operations to conduct the required actions for organizational refusals due to customer error/responsibility.

14.27.1. The LRS/CC has the option of assigning responsibility for management of technical order compliance of in-stock assets to the Time Compliance Technical Order Monitor.

14.33.4.3. The Inbound Element and/or inspecting activity will notify PACAF RSS Stock Control immediately of all items assigned condition code "J" (suspended in stock) for review and possible assignment of a requisition exception (REX) code to prevent unnecessary requisition action(s).

14.35.2. NOTE: MAJCOM Option. The central file of DD Forms 1348-6/AF Form 1220 will be maintained in the Customer Service Center Section.

14.36.1. MAJCOM Option. Inbound Element is responsible for working local purchase Report of Discrepancy/Supply Discrepancy Report (SF 364).

14.40.4.2. Note. Local LRS/CC option.

14.40.7. MAJCOM Option. DD Form 1576 or 1576-1 may be used to annotate in-stock functional check items.

14.41.3. The Storage Element will notify the Hazardous Material Pharmacy (HAZMART) Element who will notify Bioenvironmental Engineering Services and the Base Safety Office when suspected hazardous commodities are received into the Logistics Readiness Squadron account and have not been reviewed by the BES.

14.41.3.1. At the option of the LRS/CC, the HAZMART can input issue exception (IEX) codes 8, 9, or M into the SBSS.

14.41.4. At the option of the LRS/CC, this responsibility may be delegated to the HAZMART.

14.41.5. At the option of the LRS/CC, HAZMART personnel may review the Health Hazard Listing.

14.68.2. NOTE. MAJCOM Option. Found On Base (FOB), DIFM (ERRCD XD or XF) items may be delivered to Flightline Service Center instead of Storage Element for processing.

14.68.3. MAJCOM Option. FOB property for recoverable items (ERRC XD/XF) may be delivered to the Flightline Service Center for research and processing.
