AFI 36-2817, 23 January 2004, is supplemented as follows:

2.6. The Frank R. Cox Award.

2.6.1. Purpose and Description of Award. The annual award honors Mr. Frank R. Cox, who dedicated his entire career (1950-1992) to Air Force fire protection and made monumental contributions to fire stations, vehicles, training, and fire prevention programs throughout PACAF. It recognizes the most outstanding Fire Protection Flight for achieving the highest degree of excellence in base mission support and fire protection management. The winner of this award will be the PACAF nominee for the Air Forces' Ralph E. Sanborn Award.

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
