**COMPLIANCE AND STANDARDIZATION
REQUIREMENTS LIST (C&SRL) FOR
NUMBERED AIR FORCE (NAF) AND AIR
OPERATIONS CENTER (AOC)
INTELLIGENCE (IN) FUNCTIONAL AREA**

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This Mission Performance Checklist directory implements AFD 90-2, *Inspector General -- The Inspection System* and AFI 90-201, *Inspector General Activities*. It applies to AOC/NAF/AIS intelligence organizations. The Mission Performance Checklist will assist units in developing a comprehensive self-inspection program. This directory applies to all PACAF-gained National Guard Bureau (NGB) units and members. Portions of this directory are applicable to Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC) units and members. AFRC personnel should carefully review this directory for applicable portions.

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1. General. The items listed do not constitute the order or limit the scope of inspections or assessments. As a minimum, Commanders should use this directory in conjunction with annual self-assessments to identify deficiencies that could degrade mission effectiveness. AOC/AIF/NAF may supplement this publication to add internal compliance items. This directive may be used in whole or in part by HHQ during visits or exercises. Users may add any items that, in the exercise of good judgment, require examination. The Commander may designate responsibility of tasks.

1.1. **Critical Compliance Objectives (CCO).** Items defined by the PACAF staff as key result areas for successful mission accomplishment including, but not limited to, items where non-compliance would result in serious injury, loss of life, excessive cost, or litigation. **CCOs ARE BOLD, ALL CAPS AND MARKED WITH (CCO).**

1.2. **Core Compliance Items (CCI).** Areas that require special vigilance and are important to the overall performance of the unit, but are not deemed “critical.” Non-compliance would result in some negative impact on mission performance or could result in injury, unnecessary cost, or possible litigation. **CCIs are bold, and marked with (CCI).**

1.3. **General Compliance Items (GCI).** Areas deemed fundamental to the successful overall performance of the unit, but non-compliance would result in minimal impact on mission accomplishment or would be unlikely to result in injury, increased cost, or possible litigation. GCIs are shown in normal font.
