This mission directive implements policy guidance in AFPD 38-1, *Organization*, AFI 38-101, *Air Force Organization*, AFPD 10-1, *Mission Directives*, and AFI 10-101, *Format and Content of Mission Directives*. It does not apply to the Air National Guard or the United States Air Force Reserve. Its purpose is to prescribe unit mission, organization, and processes.

**1. Mission.** Plans, conducts, controls, and coordinates air operations in accordance with (IAW) the tasks assigned by the Commander, Pacific Air Forces (COMPACAF). Maintains a level of readiness necessary for successful completion of directed military operations.

**2. Command.** The 11 AF Commander:

- 2.1. Commands and controls air operations as assigned or directed by COMPACAF.
- 2.2. Exercises command over 3rd Wing (3 WG), 354th Fighter Wing (354 FW), 611th Air Operations Group (611 AOG), and 611th Air Support Group (611 ASG).
- 2.3. Provides United States Air Force (USAF) forces and exercises operational control (OPCON) of USAF component of Alaskan Command (ALCOM).
- 2.4. Provides air force forces for the Alaskan NORAD Region.
- 2.5. Responds to COMPACAF for administration.
- 2.6. Fills a joint position as Commander, Alaskan Command (COMALCOM), a subordinate unified command of United States Pacific Command (USPACOM). As COMALCOM, commands, controls, and coordinates joint and combined operations as a subordinate unified command in Alaska or as a deployed joint task force headquarters.

2.7. Is the Commander, Alaskan NORAD Region (ANR) and, as such, exercises OPCON over all North American Aerospace Defense (NORAD) forces in the ANR. Serves as principal adviser to Commander in Chief, North American Aerospace Defense (CINCNOAD) on matters pertaining to the ANR. Coordinates on matters of mutual interest and refers matters of disagreement to CINCNOAD for resolution. Provides Headquarters NORAD the readiness status of all assigned units.

### 3. Assigned Forces.

3.1. 3d Wing: F-15C/D (36), F-15E (18), C-130H (16), C-12F (2), C-12J(1), E-3B/C (2)

3.2. 354th Fighter Wing: OA-10A (6), A-10 (6), F-16C/D (18)

### 4. Responsibilities. The 11 AF Commander:

4.1. Provides force protection assessments, measures, and resources to meet known and possible threats to the mission.

4.2. Provides air forces for ALCOM when directed by COMPACAF.

4.3. Provides air forces for ANR.

4.4. Through PACAF, provides combat-ready forces, support, and equipment to unified commands when directed by Commander in Chief, United States Pacific Command (USCINCPAC).

4.5. Coordinates and controls military forces conducting search-and-rescue operations in Alaska.

4.6. Provides and maintains infrastructure and support for NORAD in the ANR.

4.7. Exercises OPCON over PACAF-gained Air National Guard (ANG) and Air Force Reserve (AFRES) units when mobilized or recalled to active duty and operations in the 11 AF area of responsibility (AOR).

4.8. Executes management oversight for environmental issues.

4.9. Exercises general courts martial authority.

4.10. Provides safety program oversight.

4.11. Executes other missions as directed by COMPACAF.

4.12. When appointed, serves as COMPACAF-designated Commander, Air Component Command (CACC).

4.13. Coordinates and integrates space capabilities.

4.14. Coordinates and integrates information operations (IO) capabilities.

4.15. Represents COMPACAF in the interdepartmental, interservice, and international activities with 11 AF AOR.

**5. Area of Responsibility.** The 11 AF AOR is defined as:

45° 30' north 159° east

40° north 159° east

continue along the 40 degree north latitude to:

40° north 155° west

48° 20' north 132° west

48° 20' north 125° west

51° north 129° 40' west

54° 40' north 130° 45' west

then along the Alaskan Canadian border to:

80° north 141° west



then along the coastline to:

50° 45' north 157° east

- The organization and other AF organizations, government agencies, US Military Services, and the armed forces and government agencies of other nations.

**Assigned Forces**--Assigned weapon systems

**Responsibilities**--Mission elements assigned by unified commanders, specified commanders, or higher authorities. Define the commander's responsibility for executing those elements of the mission.

**Area of Responsibility (AOR)**--Geographical AOR applies at NAF level only.

**Organization Chart**--Self-explanatory
