**FULL SPECTRUM THREAT RESPONSE
(FSTR) PLANNING AND OPERATIONS**

COMPLIANCE WITH THIS PUBLICATION IS MANDATORY

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AFI 10-2501, 24 December 2002, is supplemented as follows: This supplement implements 43d Airlift Wing, Pope AFB, North Carolina policy by supplementing specific processes and procedures that are unique to Pope AFB. It applies to all 43d Airlift Wing units and Associate Tenant units. This supplement reflects a “Full Spectrum Threat Response” compliance-oriented philosophy and supports the 43d Airlift Wing Organization and assigned Tenants. Key managers must review General Responsibilities Chapter 2 and Attachment 2, Installation Functional Support to determine their requirements to support the FSTR program. This supplement adds clarification for the 43d Airlift Wing Structure along with assigned Tenant’s specific requirements to support the wing’s FSTR program. Unit commanders will publish local FSTR program requirements in unit checklists and operating instructions as necessary. 2.17.1. Unit commanders will appoint a primary and alternate unit representative (E-5 or above) to manage/coordinate unit requirements of the Pope AFB FSTR program. Representatives will establish and maintain a unit FSTR program using guidance provided by 43 CES Readiness.

2.17.1.1. (Added) Unit FSTR Representative will use the Quarterly Unit FSTR Report to update all unit FSTR position assignments (i.e. Unit FSTR Representatives, DCG, and Specialized Team members).

2.17.5. Unit commanders will appoint a primary and alternate DCG representative in writing using Quarterly Unit FSTR Report. When appointed the wing DCG will consist of representatives (Officer O-1 thru O-5 and NCO E-6 thru E-9) as a minimum from the following organizations.

2.17.6.1. (Added) Unit FSTR Representative will use Quarterly Unit FSTR Report to document the status of scheduled/completed FSTR training of unit personnel.

2.17.10.1. (Added) Unit FSTR Representative will use Quarterly Unit FSTR Report to document checks of FSTR related equipment.

2.17.12.1. (Added) In accordance with Pope AFB FSTR Plan 10-2 and *Pope AFB Guide to Sheltering-In-Place as a Protective Action*, Facility Managers will implement, as appropriate, shelter-in-place procedures.

2.17.13. Provide personnel requirements to the installation Resource Augmentation Duty (READY) program IAW PAFBI 10-243, *Augmentation Program*.

2.17.13.1. (Added) 43 AW Ready Augmentation Program Manager will ensure that 10 personnel are identified to fill the Readiness Support Team (RST) augmentee requirements.

2.17.16.1. 43 SVS/CC will staff and (within 24 hours of shelter activation) coordinate with 43 CES/CEX for Just In Time (JIT) training of appointed shelter management team personnel.

7.1.1. AFOSI Det 324/CC will maintain and brief current WMD threat assessment as required.

7.2.1. AFOSI Det 324/CC will immediately notify the FBI when a WMD incident has occurred.
