AFI 32-6001, 26 April 1994, is supplemented as follows: This Pope supplement has been revised to reflect commander directed changes to key and mission essential positions for which incumbents will be required to reside on Pope Air Force Base as a matter of military necessity.

2.3. Personal preference options for family housing will be authorized as follows:

- 2.3.1. Senior Officer - No Preference
- 2.3.2. Field Grade Officer - No Preference
- 2.3.3. Company Grade Officer - No Preference
- 2.3.4. Senior Enlisted - No Preference
- 2.3.5. Junior Enlisted - Cardinal Heights/Hillcrest
- 2.3.6. 2 Bedroom - Cardinal Heights/Hillcrest/Ethridge
- 2.3.7. 3 Bedroom - Cardinal Heights/Hillcrest
- 2.3.8. 4 Bedroom - Cardinal Heights/Hillcrest

3.1.1. One unit on Maynard Street is designated as General Officer Quarters for assignment to the 43d Airlift Wing Commander. Eight units on Maynard Street are designated as Senior Officer Quarters. The 43d Airlift Wing Commander will determine the priority of assignment of these quarters. One unit is identified as the permanent quarters of the incumbent of the following positions:

<u>Quarters Number</u>	<u>Position</u>
218 Maynard	Commander, 43d Airlift Wing
18 Hercules	Command Chief Master Sergeant, 43d Airlift Wing

3.2. Installation commanders identify positions as key and mission essential and require the incumbents to reside on the installation as a matter of military necessity in order to facilitate their response to any situation, which requires immediate presence. The 43d Airlift Wing Commander may waive the requirement for incumbents of these positions to reside on base.
