AFI 33-360 Volume 1, 30 January 2004 is supplemented as follows: This supplement prescribes specific guidance for all Pope AFB publications customers. It applies to all personnel who prepare, manage, coordinate, review, certify, or use publications on Pope AFB. **Records Disposition:** Documentation created by this publication will be maintained and disposed of IAW AFMAN 37-123, *Management of Records* and AFMAN 37-139, *Records Disposition Schedule*.

3.17.2. (Added) When preparing the publication for coordination with appropriate units, OPRs will list 43 CS/SCBIP as the first and last office for coordination on the AF IMT 673. The OPR will obtain all coordinations from units with technical or functional interest and then forward the package to the appropriate authority (para 1.11) for certification. When publication is ready for staffing to the 43d Airlift Wing commander for approval, the OPR will provide all original coordinating documents, a printed copy of the publication, and the publication on disk in Microsoft Word format to 43 CS/SCBIP.

3.18.2. (Added) The 43d Airlift Wing commander assumes approval authority for all Pope AFB publications.

3.22.1. (Added) The OPR must contact the NCOIC, Content Management, 43 CS/SCBIP, for a conference prior to initiating coordination of a new or revised base publication. The conference will consist of a basic edit of the publication for spelling, grammar and format; issuance of a Pope Electronic Publishing Guide; recommendations to the OPR on the coordination process; and instructions on the use of the Publications Matrix (para 3.17.1).
