SHIPMENTS

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AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 15, is supplemented as follows:

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This supplement deletes all Exception Control processes regarding the Individual Equipment Element; adds off-line serial numbers for Pick-Up and Delivery Section to give to organizations shipping directly to Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office (DRMO); deletes Shipment Exception Code B.

15.9.2. The PLSC Option will not be used.

15.9.3. The option to suppress the DD Form 1348-1A, **Issue Release/Receipt Document**, will not be used.

15.9.4. The shipment suspense details will not be suppressed.

15.10.2. The option to suppress DD Form 1348-1A will not be used

15.10.3. The shipment suspense details will not be suppressed.

15.10.4. The Collocated Account Option will not be used.

15.43.6.3. This option will not be used.

15.48. When TRMs are processed using TEX Codes 5, E, L, N, V or @, the requestor must obtain approval from the Stock Control supervisor, who will maintain the approval file.

15.50. Property will be moved to DRMO in accordance with AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 15, *Shipments*, paragraph 15.50.3.

15.64. Inspection personnel will process all TRMs from stock for hazardous items. Items still serviceable based on condition and/or shelf-life extension may be placed in free-issue status. (May still be serviceable and can be used for other than designed purpose.) This procedure is covered by AFI 32-7086, *Hazardous Materials Management*. Documents will be certified "ITEMS PLACED IN FREE ISSUE."

15.67.1. Option 2 will be used with the exception of the 375th Civil Engineering Squadron, which is assigned Document Numbers 8050-8300 for direct transfer of scrap to DRMO. The Pick-Up and Delivery Section will be the central point for other organizations. Off-line Serial Document Numbers 9160-9199 will be used for other organizations.
