AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 26, is supplemented as follows:

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

The revised supplement deletes paragraph 26.2.4.1., Scott AFB Supply Contract Requirements for WRM Management; realigns functional check responsibilities from the War Readiness Element (WRE) to chief inspector; updates the unit's responsibility to provide inventory data on mobility bag items maintained by the WRE for updating Mobility Inventory Control Accountability System. **A bar (|) indicates a revision from the previous edition.**

26.8.2. War Readiness will use a locally devised R32 for quarterly review of dated items.

26.8.2.3. This option is not used.

26.8.2.4. Not applicable at Scott AFB.

| 26.9.1. The chief supply inspector will be responsible for the entire accounts functional check program.

26.9.3. Items pending functional check will be stored in the Suspended Storage Area.

26.19.1. The 375 LRS/LGRF will co-manage liquid oxygen and deicing fluid.

26.26.2.2. Non-Airborne RSP (R52) and a logbook will be used for short-term deployment.

| 26.45.2.1. The using activity will report inventory data (i.e., on-hand and deployed quantities) on a monthly basis to the War Readiness Element.

26.73.2.6. The 375 LRS/CC will sign the completed S05.
