SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

3.2. Special Command Positions (SCP). General/flag officers, general/flag officer selectees, and incumbents of general/flag officer billets will be assigned to the following quarters: 153-E/W, 154-N/S, 156-N/S, 158-N/S, 160-N/S, 162-E/W, 163, 200, 201, 227, 229, and 231. The following senior officer quarters are set aside to satisfy command and key position requirements: 179-N/S, 180-N/S, 181-N/S, 182-N/S, 183-N/S, 184-N/S, 185-N/S, 186-N/S, 187-N/S, and 189-N/S; Galaxy SOQ Housing; Buildings 171-N/S, 173-N/S, 175-N/S, 234-N/S, 236-N/S, 237-N/S, 238-N/S, 239-N/S, 240-N/S and 241-N/S, located at Scott AFB, are designated Prestige Senior NCO quarters; Unit 175-S is designated for the Air Mobility Command (AMC) Command Chief Master Sergeant, Unit 175-N for 18th Air Force (18 AF) Command Chief Master Sergeant, and Unit 239-S for 375th Airlift Wing (AW) Command Chief Master Sergeant.

3.3. Command Positions. The 375 AW Commander provides the Housing Management Office specifics on the assignment of all quarters for general/flag and senior officer positions designated in this supplement. Additions or deviations must be fully justified by letter through the 375th Mission Support Group (MSG) Commander. Unless the waiver provisions of this paragraph apply, when an incumbent of a key position is permitted to reside off base by his or her commander, the position will be considered for deletion from this supplement by his or her commander. Personnel occupying designated positions, who subsequently PCA to a non-designated position, will not normally be required to vacate their assigned set-aside quarters; however, these cases will be decided on an individual basis considering the needs of the service. Key personnel who do not qualify for general/flag or senior officer quarters will be placed at the top of the appropriate waiting list. Quarters 180N/S is identified as key and essential for the 375 AW.

Quarters 227 is identified for the Vice Commander, HQ AMC. Quarters 229 is identified for the Commander, United States Transportation Command (USTRANSCOM), and Commander, HQ AMC, who occupies a special designated command position. Quarters 231 is identified for the Deputy Commander, USTRANSCOM.

3.4. **Key and Mission Essential Positions.** Incumbents of the following command and key/essential positions will be assigned appropriate quarters from those set aside. All other senior officers will be assigned appropriate quarters in accordance with their grade and bedroom entitlement. Key personnel who do not qualify for senior officer quarters will be placed at the top of the waiting list appropriate to their grade. Priority for assignment will be to command positions first then key positions. Incumbents of these positions will be assigned to the designated or set-aside quarters to the maximum extent possible.

3.5. Unaccompanied Personnel and Designated Positions. The 375 AW Commander will request permission from HQ AMC/A7 for approval to temporarily convert a Military Family Housing unit to accommodate an unaccompanied member who fills one of the positions listed in paragraph 3.4. of this supplement. The period is not to exceed 3 years. If approval is not provided, the member will have to

locate quarters off base. When an assignment extends beyond 3 years, the unaccompanied member residing in base housing will be required to move off base at government expense. Temporary lodging space is not considered appropriate housing and will not be used as an unaccompanied member's residence.

6.3. **Personal Preference Options.** Due to the wide variance in style and type of family housing for 3-bedroom Company Grade Officers and 3-bedroom Senior Non-Commissioned Officers, they are authorized to exercise a personal preference option in selecting their new quarters.
