ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE PROGRAM

COMPLIANCE WITH THIS PUBLICATION IS MANDATORY

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**AFI 34-219, 9 September 1998, is supplemented as follows:**

**SUMMARY OF REVISIONS**

**This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.**

Authorizes the Installation Commander to establish a drinking age in accordance with state law; designates installation facilities who may sell alcoholic beverages.

1.1.2. In accordance with Illinois State Law, it is illegal to serve or sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 21 years old.

2.1. **Governing Criteria.** The Scott Club and the Golf Course may sell alcoholic beverages (including distilled spirits) for on-premise consumption. The Bowling Center, Pronto's Pizza, Rod and Gun Club, and sports facilities (except youth fields) may sell beer and wine coolers for on-premise consumption. All authorized activities are subject to the restrictions of AFI 34-219, *Alcoholic Beverage Program*. Rod and Gun Club patrons will not engage in alcoholic consumption before using firearms or while on the firing range. The Services organization may also sell beer and wine coolers at base-wide events.

2.1.2. Lodging managers are authorized to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premise consumption in accordance with the guidelines contained in AFI 34-219.

2.1.6. The following base-related facilities are authorized to serve alcoholic beverages: Government housing and dormitories, base picnic areas (organizational events will comply with AFI 34-219 prior to serving malt beverages and/or low alcoholic beverages), and the base Family Campground. **NOTE:** No person without prior approval of the Installation Commander may buy, sell, procure, provide, possess or drink any alcoholic beverages or malt beverages at work or storage areas on Scott AFB. Persons or organizations sponsoring activities for which the Installation Commander has approved consumption of alcoholic beverages or malt beverages will ensure compliance with AFI 34-219. Sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages in other non-Services areas not otherwise designated for this purpose may be autho-

alized by the Installation Commander on a case-by-case basis, provided the beverages are sold and dispensed by an authorized Services activity.

3.2. **Base Services Activities.** The Scott Club may sell beer, wine coolers, and other premixed, commercially packaged alcoholic beverages with less than seven percent alcoholic content by volume for off-premise consumption. Sales must be restricted to time periods when AAFES-operated retail outlets are closed. Pricing policies must comply with AFI 34-219, paragraph 3.6.

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
