



FAMILY HOUSING MANAGEMENT

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OPR: 60 CES/CEH (Mr. Mark DuPree)
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AFI 32-6001, 23 January 2002, is supplemented as follows: This supplement implements Air Force Policy Directive (AFPD) 32-60, *Housing*. It establishes policies and procedures for the assignment of key and essential personnel to military family housing. The processes identify the positions and/or housing addresses where Travis AFB key and essential personnel will reside.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

Due to heightened base security for Travis AFB, additional key personnel are required to reside on Travis AFB. Paragraph **2.2.2. (Added)** is added. **A bar (|) indicates revision from the previous edition.**

2.1. Family Housing Categories. The following positions require designated units:

2.1.1. (Added) The following other services' positions are key and essential and will reside in on-base officer housing. In order to maintain flexibility to accommodate overlaps and additions, the base housing office is not limited to housing the key and essential personnel in specific addresses:

2.2. **Equitable Use of Housing Assets.** The following are key and mission essential personnel and incumbents required to reside on the installation. The housing office does not hold units vacant for this category, but incumbents are given the highest priority in their respective grade and bedroom requirement category:

2.2.1. (Added) Should the incumbent desire to reside off base; a waiver request may be submitted for review through 60 MSG/CC for approval/disapproval by the installation commander.

2.2.2. (Added) Accompanied Travis Squadron Commanders may be designated as Key and Essential and be required to live on base. Travis Group Commanders are granted authority to designate their Squadron Commanders as Key and Essential based on operational requirements, mission readiness, safety, and/or security.

3.1. **Designated Positions.** The following housing units are designated as senior NCO prestige housing. Both Bradley homes will revert to SOQs when incumbents PCS/retire:
