AFI32-7042, 12 May 1994, is supplemented as follows:

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

Restructures the method of initial training and updates office titles and symbols throughout. A bar (|) indicates revisions from the previous edition.

2.3.1. Initial hazardous waste training is accomplished via a classroom setting provided by the 10th Civil Engineering Environmental Flight (10 CES/CEV). After completing the prescribed training, personnel must pass, with a minimum score of 70%, an examination administered by 10 CES/CEV. Annual refresher training is accomplished each February through training sessions provided by 10 CES/CEV. All personnel handling hazardous waste, on the Academy, must schedule to attend one of the training sessions, and then pass a quiz to document comprehension of hazardous waste regulations.

2.5.1.2. A primary and alternate manager must be appointed by official correspondence to 10 CES/CEV. Documented inspections of initial accumulation points (accumulation locations) must be accomplished weekly. USAFA Form 83, **Weekly Inspection Log for Hazardous Waste Initial Accumulation Points (IAP)**, may be used to document these inspections.

2.6.2.1. (Added) . For hazardous waste, generators will complete a separate copy of USAFA Form 86, **Hazardous Waste Turn-In**, for each type of waste they are turning in. As specified in the instructions on the form, complete items 1 through 9 and attach a copy of the Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) or furnish the national stock number (NSN) and manufacturer for each waste. USAFA Form 86 has been modified to update phone and building numbers and provide for a waste description block. After the form has been properly filled out, contact 10 CES/CEV to arrange for turn in.

2.11. **Forms Prescribed** : USAF Form 83, **Weekly Inspection Log for Hazardous Waste Initial Accumulation Points (IAP)**, and USAFA Form 86, **Hazardous Waste Turn-In**.
