4.3. (Added) Forms Purpose. USAFA Form 145 evaluates a candidates' character, USAFA Form 146 collects a candidates' personal information and information regarding arrest records and/or suspension from school; USAFA Form 147 provides information regarding a candidates participation in high school athletic and non-athletic activities; USAFA Form 148 provides information regarding a candidates high school performance; USAFA Form 149 is the initial application to USAFA and is used to evaluate an applicants' potential to compete for an appointment; USAFA Form 149a is used to select students to attend the Summer Seminar and also used in place of USAFA Form 149; USAFA office form, Candidate Writing Sample, allows a candidate to express themselves to the Academy Selection Panel; USAFA office form, Candidate Physical Aptitude Exam, evaluates a candidates physical condition.

5. (Added) **Information Collections, Records, and Forms.**

5.1. (Added) **Information Collections.** This publication requires the collection and maintenance of information protected by the Privacy Act of 1974. 10 U.S.C. 9346 and EO 9397 authorize the collection and maintenance of data prescribed in this publication.

5.2. (Added) **Records.** Maintain and dispose of records created as a result of prescribed processes in accordance with AFMAN 37-139, *Records Disposition Schedule*.
