AFI 36-2833, 23 October 2002, is supplemented as follows:

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

To include safety award eligibility for teams and civilian contractors.

Section AC (Added)–USAFA Safety Awards

112. (Added) Purpose. United States Air Force Academy (USAFA) safety awards have the dual purpose of recognizing deserving individuals, units, teams and civilian contractors and publicizing positive aspects of the safety program.

112.1. (Added) Nomination Procedures. The nominee's organizational commander prepares the nomination and submits it to HQ USAFA Safety (HQ USAFA/SE) no later than 30 October. Nominations must include the following:

112.1.1. (Added) The nominee's name, grade, organizational unit, and duty title.

112.1.2. (Added) An unclassified narrative description of the nominee's contribution, not to exceed 28 lines.

112.2. (Added) Selection Procedures. HQ USAFA/SE conducts a selection board and recommends winners to HQ USAFA Director of Staff (HQ USAFA/DS) for approval.

112.3. (Added) Award Presentation. HQ USAFA Superintendent or designated representative presents the award to the individual or unit at a ceremony arranged by HQ USAFA/SE.

112.4. (Added) Submission. Submit nominations on AF Form 1206, **Nomination for Award**.

Section AD (Added)—Unit Safety Representative of the Year Award

113. (Added) Purpose. This award gives the US Air Force Academy an opportunity to recognize a deserving Unit Safety Representative (USR) for outstanding contributions in the field of safety.

113.1. (Added) **Eligibility.** All assigned military or civilian USAF Academy USRs (primary or alternate).

113.2. (Added) **Selection Criteria.** Individual sustained noteworthy performance in support of USAFA safety programs.

113.2.1. (Added) Outstanding compliance with occupational safety, fire prevention, and health program requirements in their areas of responsibility.

113.2.2. (Added) Safety performance beyond what is normally expected of a USR that prevented or reduced the effects of a serious mishap or made a significant impact on the mishap prevention program.

113.2.3. (Added) Excelling in responsibilities outlined in the Academy Unit Safety Representatives Management Guide.

Section AE (Added)—Individual, Team, or Unit Safety Award of the Year (Ground, Flight or Explosives/Weapons)

116. (Added) Purpose. This award gives the US Air Force Academy an opportunity to recognize deserving individuals or teams for an outstanding contribution to the USAFA mishap prevention program in one or more categories (Ground, Flight, or Explosives/Weapons Safety).

116.1. (Added) **Eligibility.** Military, civilian personnel, civilian contractor, or teams assigned to the USAF Academy including tenant personnel.

116.2. (Added) **Selection Criteria.** Individual sustaining outstanding performance or an outstanding act in support of the USAFA mishap prevention program.

Section AF (Added)—USAFA Safety Achievement Awards

117. (Added) Purpose. This award gives the US Air Force Academy an opportunity to recognize deserving individuals, units, teams and civilian contractors at any time, who have made a significant impact in the mishap prevention program through a single act or sustained performance.

117.1. (Added) **Eligibility.** Military and civilian personnel, civilian contractor and teams, and units assigned to the US Air Force Academy, including tenant personnel or units.

117.2. (Added) **Selection Criteria.** Individual, team, or unit performing an outstanding feat or sustaining outstanding performance in support of USAFA Safety Program.

117.2.1. (Added) Performing outstanding feats beyond what is normally expected that have prevented or reduced the effects of a serious mishap.

117.2.2. (Added) Error or neglect resulting in a mishap disqualifies the nominee even though the nominee's later actions satisfy selection criteria.

117.2.3. (Added) Performing a single act or sustained performance beyond what is normally expected in promoting the USAFA mishap prevention program. **NOTE:** HQ USAFA/SE may also nominate deserving individuals for any safety awards.
