AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 11, CD dated July 2004 is supplemented as follows: The following supplement explains the issue procedures that are basic to the Supply process. This supplement applies to all USAFE units. It does not apply to US Air Force Reserve (AFRC) or Air National Guard (ANG) units. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with AFMAN 37-123, *Management of Records* and disposed of in accordance with the Air Force Records Disposition Schedule (RDS) located at <https://webrims.amc.af.mil/>.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

The Logistics Readiness Squadron (LRS) Commander, the Chief of Supply (COS) and the Accountable Officer are one and the same when referenced in the basic regulation. NOTE: Naval Air Station (NAS) Keflavik, Iceland is designated as a Logistics Readiness Flight (LRF) within the Civil Engineer Squadron and guidance is the same as for the LRS. This supplement deletes the requirement on the delete code 7 withdrawals from mobility readiness spares package (MRSP) to prevent mission capable (MICAP) as an incident. Issue exception code (IEX) "Y" added since last publication to identify Air Force Repair Enhancement Program (AFREP) assets in paragraph **11A9.3**. A vertical bar in the left margin indicates revised information from the previous edition.

11.3.2.2. Requests for non-equipment authorization inventory data (EAID) items (activity code "P") are submitted to the Customer Service Center in the LRS.

11.4.1.2. **NOTE:** The LRS Commander may opt to record supply actions and delivery times on the control register.

11.4.1.2.1. The LRS Commander has the option to direct the destruction of copy 2.

11.11.2.4. If cancellation of a kill is desired, enter the name of the individual authorizing the cancellation in the management notice I004 block D (DD Form 1348-1A, **Issue Release/Receipt Document**), if sent to the requesting organization or activity.

11.14.1.1. (Added) Issue accountability and funding differ considerably for locally procured liquid gaseous oxygen and nitrogen (LOX/LIN) versus products generated by Air Force owned and operated plants. **NOTE:** Lajes AB is the only USAFE base with a production plant. For LOX/LIN procured locally, paragraph **11.14.1.1.2. (Added)** will apply.

11.14.1.1.2. (Added) LRS Customer Service representatives and the Fuels Management Officer will be the base focal points to determine emergency LOX/LIN requirements. Customer Service personnel will maintain emergency levels for part number items which will be managed by host LRS to support base requirements when the cryogenics plant is not operational. The LRS will accomplish off-line receipt, storage and issue and establish local procedures to effectively control, inventory, issue and deliver.

11A1.3.3.2.2. Copy 2 of the due-in-from-maintenance issue (DIFM) request is given to customer signing for the property.

11A9.2.1. Quarterly, URSS Stock Control will forward the Exception Phrase Listing (R03/NGV870) and instruct all LRS Customer Service Sections to conduct a validation of all locally-assigned issue exception (IEX) codes P-Z. Exception phrase change and deletion requests will be forwarded to URSS Records Maintenance for processing. Record Maintenance will notify Customer Service when processing actions have been completed. Validations will be documented and saved by LRS Customer Service until the next review. **NOTE:** Any locally assigned IEX codes will be published in a local supplement to this chapter.

11A9.3. Supplement Table 11A9.2. as follows: ENC Codes: Supply restriction of Barrier Material, National Stock Number (NSN) 8135-00-282-0565. This NSN has been found to be a contributing factor in a serious explosive mishap. Testing revealed that this material (MIL-B-131H) will accept and retain an electrical charge and cannot be grounded to dissipate the charge. This is extremely hazardous in munitions operations involving electro-explosive devices. To prevent this item from ever being issued out to a munitions unit, we direct that each LRS load a local IEX code.

Attachment 11A-9, Table 11A9.2. ENC Codes, **NOTE: 1.** The exception code control (ECC) image on NSN 8135-00-282-0565 (IEX “Q”) will include the following information: Use NSN 8135-00-092-3220 (MIL-B-81705C) in munitions environment. No substitutes are authorized. **NOTE: 2.** IEX Code “Y” is assigned to identify AFREP assets. Exception phrases that contain an asterisk (*) in the first position will be printed on the issue document.

11A15.3.2.2.1. At the option of the LRS Commander, destroy copies of management notice I023, *Other Asset Data Follows*, for non-DIFM requests or forward to the organization.

11A15.4.2. If the customer cancels a requirement, the LRS Commander has the option to send the I004 management notice to the organization or activity with the name of the individual authorizing the cancellation entered in block "D" (DD Form 1348-1A) of the notice.
