Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 21, United States Air Force Supply Manual is supplemented as follows. This publication applies to all Air National Guard (ANG) units. SUMMARY OF CHANGES

This supplement was changed to address a change in the basic publication. It adds COMSEC/CCI points of contact/monitors requirements for the ANG. Identifies NSNs for Rickenbacker LRS.

21.72.1. Load support record for NSNs 2835-01-437-1578, 2835-01-242-8063, 2835-01-241-2308, 2835-01-242-2189, 2835-01-007-7955. RIC FOR FB6356, Rickenbacker the designated centralized repair activity is DLK.

21.72.2. Option two is the method that will be used to identify items for automatic shipment.

21.72.3. Use the fill or pass option with blank advice code for requisitions of items identified in this supplement Para 21.72.1a. Leaving the advice code blank will automatically send the requisition to Rickenbacker first and if they have assets they will fill your requirement if not requisition will pass to depot.

21.72.4. Maintenance will turn-in the NSNs identified in Para 21.72.1 with maintenance action taken code D. Repaired serviceable assets will be turned-in by Maintenance to LRS who will turn-in assets to stock. Rickenbacker LRS will maintain a buffer stock of serviceable assets to fill supported units fill or pass requirements.

21.118. **(Added)** Post Deployment Processing of L73 (Demand Data/Consumption/Transfer Collector) program. Redeploying units that transferred their RSP or established an account on another SBSS account must ensure the L73 program is scheduled and processed within ten days of returning to home station. The L73 program captures demand data from the deployed SBSS account for upload into the unit's (home station) SBSS. Deployed units will coordinate with the responsible Supply Chain Management Group (SCMG), and/or the hosting supply account at the deployed site, to ensure the L73 is processed; demand data captured and uploaded in their home base SBSS account.

21.118.1. **(Added)** The following information (parameters) must be forwarded to the SCMG of the hosting supply unit at the transferred/deployed site to process the L73:

21.118.1.1. **(Added)** Date the unit arrived at the contingency site (yyyyddd, four digit year with the three-digit Julian date, exp. 2004091).

21.118.1.2. **(Added)** Date the unit left the contingency site (four-digit year with the three-digit Julian date

21.118.1.3. **(Added)** Standard Reporting Designator (SRD)

21.118.1.4. **(Added)** Contingency (deployed) site system designator

21.118.1.5. **(Added)** Host (at home base) supply account system designator

21.118.1.6. **(Added)** Organization code used at the contingency site

21.118.1.7. **(Added)** The output FRR and FCL file will contain unit SRAN in the file name (exp. 1GV0*L73FRR6482 and 1GV0*L73-FCL6482) 6482 in the example being your SRAN. The SRAN in the file name prevents overwritten files.

21.118.2. **(Added)** The home base computer operations section (or the applicable SCMG) will receive the data files(s) from the contingency site to update the home base's item and repair cycle records.

21.118.3. **(Added)** Review the FRR and FCL files transferred from the contingency site before processing through the pseudo. Correct any rejects before processing other files.

21.169.2.1. **(Added)** Commanders may only appoint full-time members, i.e. AGR or Technician, as COMSEC/CCI points of contact/monitors.

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
